VB Country Market Guidelines

Hwy. 59N at VB Community Centre

June 17 – September 2, 2017

Thank you for participating and welcome to our 4th **VB Country Market**. Please review the following guidelines.

Physical set up:

- Site will open at 9:00 AM on Saturdays for vendor set up. The market opens to the public for 10:00 AM. Take down is at 1:00 PM.
- This is an outdoor market. You will be allocated a set-up space and a space for your vehicle nearby. Spaces are assigned at our discretion, in ways to allow safe passage and to maximize access to vendors.
- All spaces must be confirmed by Wednesday each week before a space is designated. Vendors are expected to supply their own table, display material and canopy or umbrella. Tables may be requested for an additional fee of \$5. Small trucks are permitted on site.
- Access to water/electrical for your display (by special arrangement)
- Indoor facility will be made available during poor weather.
- Dogs must be on a leash to be permitted.

Market Expectations:

- Vendors with Food Handlers License or FWFMB License should display it.
- All vendors are responsible for cleaning their site and removal of their own trash
- There is no exclusivity for products, however, name-brand product vendors will be given first-come priority. There is no guarantee that your product will be bought by the public.
- Any product that is not in safe, working condition or recalled for safety reasons is not permitted for sale.
- Food Vendors must comply with the **Manitoba Health Farmers Market Guidelines and the federal Canada Consumer Product Safety Act.**

For example, no person without a FWFMB License shall offer for sale:

- Potentially hazardous foods such as meat or meat products, poultry or poultry products, milk or milk products, or any uncooked food with these products as ingredients (e.g. homemade perogies, cabbage rolls, sandwiches, and cream-filled pastries). - Note: These products must be packaged, labeled and be prepared in an approved establishment.
